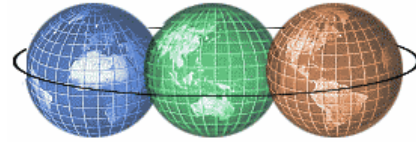


Advanced Education Pathway



11 easy steps to follow

Advanced Education Pathway

1. Read the Student Handbook and all the policies very carefully and choose the course you want to study

2. Fill out the “[Application Form](#)” and submit it to Advanced Education Pathway with relevant document. Please note: As an international student you will require the following documentation:



- *High School certificate / Diploma OR equivalent qualification*
- *Academic transcripts of your previous qualification (original or certified copies accepted only)*
- *Letter of completion of study from your previous Institution (if applicable)*
- *English Language proficiency results (IELTS 5.5 or TOEFL 550(paper), 275(CBT) - if English is not your first language*
- *Check the requirements for University (Normally IELTS 6.0 to 6.5)*

3. Advanced Education Pathway will then assess your application, help you to complete the application and advise you of the best course that suit your needs and forward it to your chosen education provider

4. If approved, the education provider will forward to you a “Letter of Offer” as the Prospective Student

5. Send the required payments to the education provider making you the offer

6. The education provider will then issue to you a “Confirmation of Enrolment (Ecoe)

7. Pay for your Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). The High Commission, Consulate or Embassy will not issue a student Visa if you **DO NOT** show proof of your **OSHC**

Depending on your country of origin and/or [assessment level](#) you may need:

- A medical check
- Evidence of sufficient funds
- Evidence of English language proficiency

8. Advanced Education Pathway will help you to complete your “Student Visa Application”. You will then await confirmation of your Student Visa.

9. Once your student visa is approved, arrange your flight booking

10. Contact your education provider to arrange [Airport Greeting](#) (Please note that there is a fee for airport pick-up) and [Accommodation Booking](#) (if you need accommodation, otherwise you can arrange for your own accommodation).

11. Attend a pre-departure briefing and receive a pre-departure guide from Advanced Education Pathway. Make sure you check laws and regulations of Customs, Health, and Immigration of your host country prior to departure.....and at last “Good Luck” in your studies
